Tapestry Gift Shop is located on the first floor of the Faith Building across from security.






The MCH Auxiliary is excited to present a new, different and exciting project we are sponsoring this year.

Matt has been a beekeeper for about 6 years. He brought some of his bees to MCH over the summer to raise and help create the observation hive with the help of Auxiliary and MCH.

To date Matt has made about 5 gallons of honey, which will be sold in 12 and 16 ounce jars in the coming weeks.
