Did You Know?

- Monroe Community Hospital (MCH) is the **12th largest stand-alone nursing facility** in the entire country.
- MCH is the **largest stand-alone nursing facility in Western New York**.
- We have established **clinical affiliations with nearly 15 local colleges and universities**. Working together, we have created a critical workforce pipeline to serve our community.
- **MCH is the first and only nursing facility in Monroe County to implement SafeGait**, a high-tech body-weight support and fall protection system that promotes patient confidence and faster recovery while enabling safer patient handling. Also, **MCH is the only inpatient facility in New York that has the C-Mill**, a virtual reality treadmill.
- Nearly **90 volunteers perform more than 11,000 hours of service** to our residents annually, assisting with patient visitation, the Tapestry Gift Shop, the Thrift Shop, the Hair Salon, and pet therapy.
- **MCH employs nearly 800 workers right here in Rochester**.
- MCH is comprised of individual nursing units which include specialty care units such as a Ventilator Unit, Pediatric Unit, Dementia Care Unit, and Rehabilitation Unit. **We care for infants as well as adults over 100 years of age**. More than **60 percent of our residents are under the age of 75** and **40 percent are under the age of 65**.
- MCH is the **only long-term care program in the region specializing in pediatric care for children** with a variety of complex medical conditions. Our newly renovated Pediatric Care Unit is a state-of-the-art skilled nursing unit. It features a fully accessible home-like setting providing for a child's medical, physical, social, and psychological needs.
- Opened in November 2018, **Monroe Community Hospital's Ventilator Unit** offers 20 beds, with the ability to provide all-day ventilator care. With state-of-the-art ventilators, monitors and therapy equipment, it is possible for residents to adjust to life with a ventilator while receiving exceptional care and working towards greater independence.
- Medical staff at MCH are provided through an affiliation with **the University of Rochester Medical Center**. The University of Rochester Geriatric Medicine Fellowship is a one-year ACGME accredited training program for board-eligible internists and family practitioners. The fellowship is based at MCH and is clinically focused on longitudinal nursing home care, rehabilitation, neurology consultation, primary care of outpatients, home care, and comprehensive geriatric and psychiatric assessment.
- **MCH was the first long-term care facility in Monroe County** and was founded as the Monroe County Almshouse in 1826. Our current building was constructed in 1933 and the name changed to the Monroe County Home and Infirmary.
- **Founded in 1966, the Monroe Community Hospital Auxiliary** is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that raises funds that enhance the quality of life of our residents and directly supports programs and services such as concerts, ceramics programs, shopping excursions and special events like the annual Classic Car Show.
- **The T. Franklin Williams, M.D. Foundation was founded in 1990**, and is a not-for-profit organization that exists to seek charitable support for Monroe Community Hospital. It supports MCH in maintaining its leadership role in the long-term care and treatment of aged, medically complex and chronically ill individuals.
