

State funding will enhance pediatric and ventilator care.

Monroe Community Hospital (MCH) will embark on one of its most transformative projects in recent years while strengthening and expanding specialized care for some of the region's youngest and most vulnerable residents, thanks to a nearly \$10.2 million state grant.

The funding, awarded through Gov. Kathy Hochul's Statewide Health Care Facility Transformation Program, is part of \$300 million supporting 50 projects across the state to expand access to inpatient, primary, behavioral, and long-term care services.

Both County Executive Adam Bello and Executive Health Director Alyssa Tallo praised the efforts of MCH staff for their dedication and service in helping to secure the funding.

MCH was one of only three organizations in Monroe County to receive funding from the program. The grant will help add more pediatric beds, enhance ventilator care, and renovate an



outdoor playground. Final plans and designs will be completed and approved by the state in the coming months.

The work will help MCH meet growing community needs and build upon the opening of Faith 4 Center, a new 25-bed Palliative Care & Hospice Center, as well as Friendship Place, a separate project opening in the summer of 2026 that will provide a safe and supportive home for individuals with dementia and wandering-like behaviors.
